GENERAL HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

As an artist or craftsperson participating in this show on 12/6/09, I agree to hold harmless The West Orange Arts Council, West Orange High School, and the West Orange Holiday Fine Arts and Crafts Show's coordinators from any and all liabilities and all claims, actions, and damages, theft, accident, or any occurrence or condition during the event or at the location. I agree to follow all of the policies and procedures contained in this application.

As this is a fine art and crafts show, I understand that no resale merchandise or products made from kits are allowed. All art and craft merchandise **MUST** be created by the artist/vendor.

All exhibits and products to be displayed and sold at this show must be socially acceptable and in good taste. W.O.A.C. will be the sole judge of product suitability for this event.

All vendor/artists are responsible for the ongoing appearance of their booth - no clutter or trash - and for cleaning up their space at the end of the show. All vendor tables **MUST be covered to the floor** with NEAT, attractive cloths (**nothing torn or wrinkled!!** and no sheets unless they are gorgeous AND ironed!!). Excess merchandise, storage bins and carts, and personal belongings must be out of public view or stored in your vehicle.

NJ sales tax is now 7%. We leave it up to you to display your NJ tax ID. Individual artists are responsible for collection and reporting of NJ state sales tax. Sale and % off signs are prohibited.

All individual radio, CD, musical instruments (unless you are demonstrating your musical product), or sound equipment is prohibited – **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Electrical outlets are limited and not necessary. The cafeteria lighting is **very** bright, but if you feel you must have extra lighting or electrical power for other reasons (please state those reasons), make that request now so we can give you a space close to an outlet. Requests to be placed near an outlet will be on a first come, first serve basis.

Set up time for WOHA&CF is from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., Sunday, December 6, 2009. Upon arrival at the school, stop at the check-in table and pick up your space assignment. **Bring a cart** so that you can get your merchandise, backdrops, etc. from your car to your space. Please use **ONLY** the doors which will be marked **VENDOR ENTRANCE**. The cafeteria is visible from the street (Pleasant Valley Way) and is an easy unload (there are no stairs). You must be completely set up by 9:30 a.m. and have removed your vehicle to the designated vendor parking area of the lot. You are expected to remain set up until the end of the fair at 4:00 p.m.
